## Procedural Video Report presentations

### Reels to remember:

- You will have 10 minutes to present your Procedural Video Report. (8 minutes to present and 2 minutes for QA and discussion).
- Upload any slides you have in the speakers' ready room up to 2 hours before your presentation time.

### Top Video Abstract Award:

- You will have 10-13 minutes to present your Procedural Video Report.
- Upload any slides you have in the speakers' ready room up to 2 hours before your presentation time.

### e-Video Presentations

**How long:** Rapid e-video Presentations are 6-minute presentations (3 minutes to display surgical video and 3 minutes for QA and Discussion).

**Where:** e-Video presentations will take place in front of the e-Poster stations in the Exhibit Hall. ***Please arrive at the e-Poster station 15 minutes prior to the start of the session.***

**How:** Presenters will present from their previously uploaded procedural video report. The e-Video will be displayed, by our IT technicians, at the e-Poster station at the time of your presentation.
